Perpignan: 2,000 demonstrators for a La Bressola college-high school

Acting against the decision of the town hall of Perpignan to preempt the site of the Convent of the Poor Clares in Vernet, the demonstrators showed their determination in Catalan colors.

About 2000 people gathered this Saturday, October 23 in Perpignan, place de Catalogne, to mark their opposition to the decision of the RN municipality of Louis Aliot on the future of the college-high school of Bressola. The City preceded the Convent of the Poor Clares that Bressola sought to build there from this Perpignan Catalan -language secondary school.

The procession in Catalan colors, along with other gegants and members of the Aire Nou de Baho, will head to the Town Hall where speeches are scheduled.

The demonstrators therefore intended to denounce the City of Perpignan's announced choice to preempt the area chosen for the establishment of the education area north of the City.
